Toombul Demolition Update

Mirvac has announced that the application to demolish structures at the flood-damaged Toombul site has been approved by the Brisbane City Council.

The demolition of such a large centre presents a range of considerations, including the:

- relocation of telecommunications towers to ensure no impact to mobile phone coverage and capacity
- · safe, continued operation of the Toombul Bus Interchange
- engagement with key service providers, such as Air Train, regarding demolition near their infrastructure

Mirvac expects demolition to commence later in the year and is estimated to take approximately 12 months to complete (depending on progress and weather conditions). Local roads, bikeways and footpaths will remain open during the demolition works.



More information will be provided to local residents as the demolition program begins.

How are assets divided in a divorce? It depends.


Where parties to the divorce have been together for a long time, have children, or share joint finances or property, the Courts will typically use the following approach when dividing assets.

First, the court will identify the property pool. This includes all assets and debts acquired during the relationship, what you brought with you to the relationship, and any you've acquired since your separation.

The court will consider the contributions of each party. This includes financial contributions such as income, inheritances, and any other property you have received, as well as non-financial contributions such as renovations to the home, homemaking and caring for children. Then, the Court will consider the future needs of the parties, such as responsibilities in relation to caring for children, health, age, and earning capacity. Finally, the Court will assess all of the above factors and determine how an adjustment of the property should be made, ensuring that any adjustment is just and equitable.

Recent changes release 'Mortgage Prisoners'

As interest rates have increased in line with the cash rate hikes over the last year, it has become harder for some mortgage holders to refinance their home loan.

However, to overcome this, some lenders are reducing what is called a 'serviceability buffer', making it easier for some borrowers to meet the criteria to refinance.

What is a serviceability buffer? Lenders are required to use a serviceability buffer when determining how much a person can borrow. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) recommends a buffer of 3%.

What has changed?

A few major lenders have announced they will reduce their serviceability buffer to 1% for applicants who

have not missed any repayments in the past 12 months and hold equity in their property (Refinance only).




Movie and Fireworks in Boyd Park, Nundah

Strongly connected to the natural world, Kym expresses herself through her flora creations.



Freda Bage 1883–1970, OBE, MSc

One of Brisbane's pioneer women, Anna Frederika (Freda) Bage, was born in 1883 in St Kilda, Victoria.

She completed an honours degree in biology at the University of Melbourne and completed a year's research in biology at Kings College London before moving to Brisbane in 1913 to be a lecturer in biology at the University of Queensland.

In 1914, Freda was appointed the first Principal of the Women's College within the University, a position she held for 33 years.

Gradually, biology slipped into the background. She was an important public figure during those 33 years.

Aside from her professional responsibilities, she was a well-known figure in many women's organisations and took part in many important volunteer activities.

Freda Bage retired in 1950 and died in Brisbane in October 1970.

She had one brother named Edward, who was killed at Gallipoli in 1915. During Freda's lifetime, her contributions were publicly recognised in a number of ways.

In 1941, she was awarded an OBE, and in 1951, she was awarded an honorary Doctorate of Laws by the University of Queensland.

In 1938, the Brisbane City Council changed the name of a historic road in Nundah, 'Old Sandgate Road', to Bage Street, Nundah, in her honour.

All funds raised on the night will go towards our domestic violence services and helping those that have experienced domestic and family violence with legal and other support.

Homelessness Week 2023

Homelessness Week 2023 (7 August) comes at a time of tremendous pressure on our local community. Increases in cost of living and demands for social and affordable housing have resulted in support services being stretched thin to meet the needs of a larger cohort.

In Queensland, rental prices have risen at a higher rate than anywhere else in the country, resulting in more people forced into unnecessary accommodation stress.

These worrying trends have significantly affected our community elders, who are the most rapidly growing cohort experiencing homelessness since 2017. Also impacted are our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and those with complex mental health circumstances, with rental affordability and insufficient social housing forcing vulnerable people into untenable and unsafe living circumstances.

Women and children in Australia are primarily affected by domestic and family violence, leading to homelessness. These individuals are searching for safe and secure accommodation due to violent circumstances at home. Unfortunately, most of them are unable to find suitable housing, leaving them with no option but to return to their abusive partners or end up homeless.

Homeless women are at a higher risk of facing domestic and family violence, as they may be forced into harmful relationships or situations out of desperation. In many abusive households, men control the finances and work, while women take on the caregiving role and are unable to support themselves financially. This often leads to homelessness for women who attempt to leave their homes.

At Northside Connect, we have firsthand experience of these added pressures, with many new community members presenting for food relief and tenancy support.

Our services offer information and referrals to housing specialist services, provide legal support, and assistance with food and other essential items.

Facts about homelessness

(from the ABS Census, 2021)



- On any given night, 122,494 people in Australia are experiencing homelessness
- One in seven people experiencing homelessness are children under 12
- 23 per cent of people experiencing homelessness are children and young people between 12 and 24
- One in five people experiencing homelessness are Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people
- · Homelessness is not 'rooflessness'. Only 6.2 per cent of people without a home are sleeping rough. The majority of homelessness is hidden - people in crisis accommodation, rooming houses, insecure housing, overcrowded dwellings or couch surfing.

Brisbane North **Community Legal Service**

The Brisbane North Community Legal Service provides access to justice through free, quality. local and accessible information, referral and legal advice.

We have two options available to clients:

Wednesday Evening Legal Service

The evening service is staffed by dedicated volunteer lawyers (many with specific expertise) and students. The appointments are generally 45 mins and offered between 6pm and 8pm every Wednesday.

Daytime Legal Service

Our daytime service is run by employed solicitors who sees clients in longer daytime appointments. Our Generalist Lawyer offers appointments on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays and our Family Lawyer in our **Domestic Violence and Family Law Clinic** specifically for women who have experienced domestic violence offers appointments on Monday, Tuesday and Friday.

All legal appointments are by appointment only. Advices will generally be given by phone. However, we endeavour to accommodate clients who do not have ready access to email and face-to-face appointments are available when required.

Like other community legal centres our service is not means-tested and takes a holistic collaborative approach, providing effective information, advice and practical referrals to specialist legal, nonlegal and multi-disciplinary services.

Lawyers and students wishing to volunteer their services to BNCLS are always welcome. We also provide community legal education, especially to schools, seniors and other groups. For further information please contact Kamal on 3260 6820.


