#### Recent legislative changes to DV laws

Recent changes to Queensland's Domestic and Family Violence legislation have changed the way Magistrates courts deal with cross-applications for domestic violence protection orders.


A cross-application is where an aggrieved (or the police on their behalf) applies for a protection order, and then the alleged perpetrator of domestic violence makes their own application against the first person. This can often happen where both spouses have committed violence or coercive behaviour against each other.

Under the new amendments, the court must now decide who is most in need of protection, and make an order accordingly. Some of the factors the court will consider when deciding who is most in need of protection include the behaviour of both parties, the history of the relationship, whether either party is particularly vulnerable, and the severity of the harm caused by each of the parties.

Allegations of domestic violence are, unfortunately, becoming must more common in our community as well as across Australia. Hopefully, these new laws will provide better protections for victims.

"Fighting for consistency and momentum"

#### This is Moira.

A proud Gunggari woman and great grandmother who is respectfully and lovingly known as Aunty Moira. She is the president of the Noonga Reconciliation Group here in North Brisbane. One of eight children, she was born in Cherbourg, an 'Aboriginal Settlement' that her grandparents were relocated to. She tells me that, despite their history, her family did well so they have spent their lives giving back and helping others to rise. This has not always been easy - even with 34 years working in both state and federal level public service and sitting at the big tables, her voice on Aboriginal and Torres

Strait Islander Peoples issues was not heard. Watching the coming and going of funding and programs with the changes of government and staffing has been (and is) frustrating.

Moira was one of the Brisbane voices that contributed to the creation of the Uluru Statement from the Heart. "What we most need is a permanent body that can consistently focus on delivering the programs that we need to effectively close the gaps, regardless of who is in power at the time."

Moira is the Community Education Counsellor at Wavell Heights High School where she supports the local Murri Kids with the full backing of the school. A tennis fan, Moira dreams of attending Wimbledon and, if it wasn't for COVID, she would have already ticked this off her list.

#### Making a life in Queensland -The Fords 1863s-1910s

From the early 1860s, Queensland's first government was anxious to have a large and industrious immigrant population and encouraged immigrants from England to settle here in Queensland.

In 1863, a total of 1,143 assisted immigrants came to Queensland from London, Scotland and Ireland. They sailed towards a place where their future was unknown.

In September that year on board the immigration sailing clipper


ship the 'Sunda' were Edwin Ford, his wife Elizabeth and their five children. On arrival their sixth child was born They came from Somerset, England to Moreton Bay, Queensland.


Edwin Ford and the family made their home, in Albion, and named their slab hut 'Palmville'. They farmed some fifteen acres of land on what is now prime residential land on the corner of Sandgate Road, and the Old Sandgate Road, now called Bonney Ave. Their children walked to the Brookes Street school in Fortitude Valley for their education. Their only other means of transport was on horseback or horse and dray. The mail run commenced in 1864 and passed through Old Sandgate Road to German Station, now Nundah, and on to Sandgate twice a week - a distance of 12 miles.

Trains weren't established until 1882 and Ford's house was not far from the Albion Railway Station. By 1899, following rapid growth, 76 trains ran daily!

Edwin was known for his beautiful garden, which was park-like to many, and his fruit garden the envy of all his neighbours. Edwin was one of a team of men who set up the first Botanical Gardens.

Visiting the Nundah Historic Cemetery, look to the right side of the pathway where you can see one of the taller monuments erected in their memory.


## Nundah Festival – a great success



Donations of any long life, nonperishable or tinned goods that are in date, are welcome.


